Chair Michael Smith called the meeting to order at 12:31 p.m. With a quorum established, the Committee took up the first order of business.

#### **Approval of January 27, 2025, Minutes**

*Upon a motion made by John McSoley and seconded by Mike Pieciak, the Committee Members voted to approve the minutes of the Finance Committee meeting of January 27, 2025, as presented.*

#### **Public Comment**

There were no public comments given during the public comment period.

#### **Standing Reports Discussion**

The Committee reviewed the previously distributed FY25 Income Statement and Balance Sheet, Variance Analysis, VSF Endowment Report, VHEIP Summary Report and AY Private Loan Volume. Meghan Metzler noted that the VSF Endowment and VHEIP have performed well. AY Private loan volume is also higher than last year. She also reviewed the changes made to the management reports to better reflect the grant revenue from a management reporting perspective. Jeffrey Kellar walked the Committee through the Variance Analysis. Meghan and Jeffrey answered questions from the Committee.

#### **2026 Loan Financing Update**

Meghan Metzler reviewed the already distributed FY26 – Bond and Balance Sheet Funding document. She explained the proposed FY26 loan funding approach and the mix bond and balance sheet funding for forecasted FY26 originations as well as potential risks. She then entertained questions from the Committee.

#### **Other Business**

Michael Smith asked Scott Giles to provide a Federal Update. Scott provided updates on the current standing of federal grants and federal loans. He also spoke on budget reconciliation and the differing budget concepts between the House and Senate, and the closure of the Department of Education.
