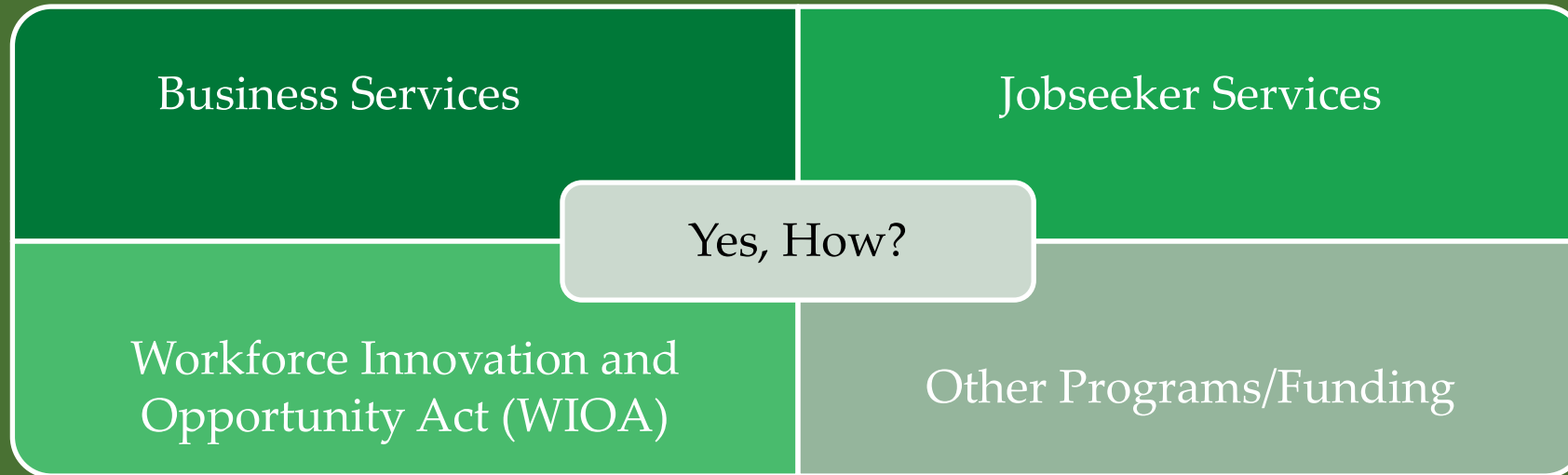

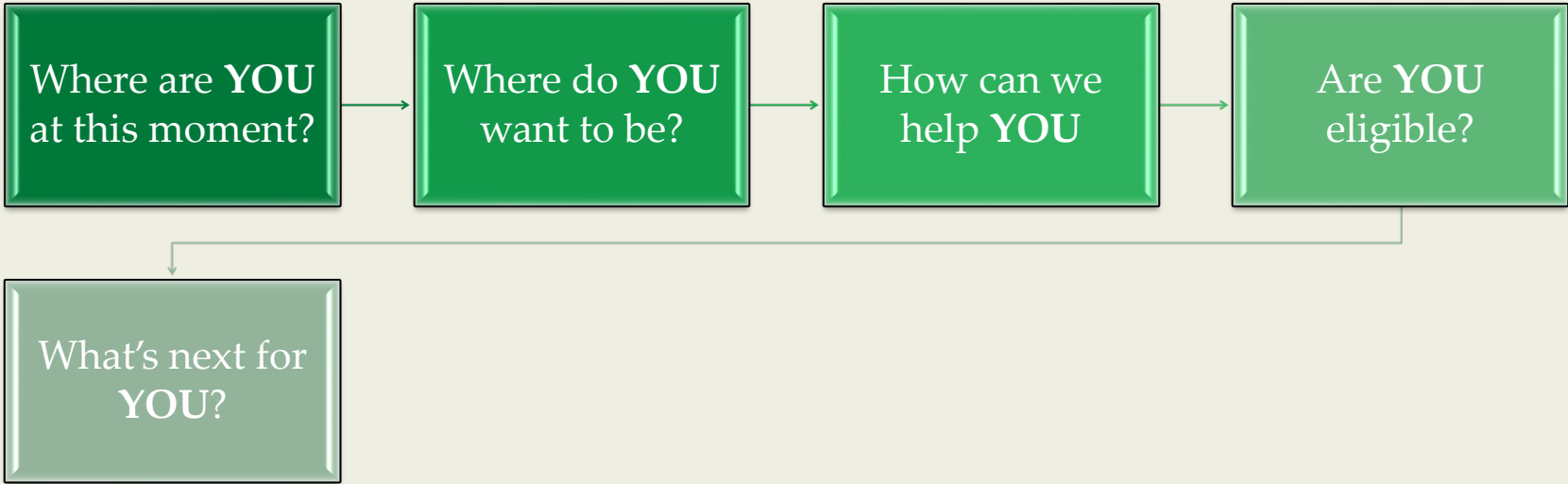

- A jobseeker whose work experience/training/skills are no longer in high demand occupations and are limited to employment opportunities
- A jobseeker who was working for a business that closed permanently or had a significant layoff, and the individual's skills are not transferable to other employment opportunities
- A jobseeker who has identified skill gaps, challenges, or limitations in obtaining employment
- A jobseeker who is interested in pursuing a career and don't know where to start
