The Steps: Application Process

Common App, or school-specific application

Application fee or fee waiver

Official transcripts

Test scores

Recommendations

Personal essay & potentially supplements

Résumé, extracurricular activities



What do colleges look at the most?

- Academics (Class Selection, Grades)
- Extracurricular Activities (Clubs, Sports)
- Essays and Writing Samples (Have someone review your essay)
- Letters of Recommendation (Pick someone who knows you well)
- Volunteer (If you are actively involved in your community, you are likely going to be involved with the student body, as well)
- Manage Your Social Media Presence (Clean up any excessive offensiveness, personal drama, and potentially offensive posts.
