



Jobs vs. Careers

- A **career** is a longterm professional journey.









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




Education & Experience

Forms of Education

- College, technical training, online certifications, apprenticeships, on-the-job training. Anything that expands your skills.
- Jobs requiring higher levels of education (greater specialization) tend to have higher wages.
- Jobs that involve higher levels of risk tend to have higher wages.


- Typical Education needed for entry High school diploma or equivalent
