Regional Student Program (RSP) Tuition Break Tuition Rate and Savings

Students pay a tuition rate that is much lower than out-of-state tuition.

Tuition rates and savings vary by college. View current rates at nebhe.org/tuitionbreak

Example of Annual Tuition Rates & Savings	
In-State Tuition Rate	\$10,000
Out-of-State Tuition Rate	\$23,000
RSP Tuition Break Tuition Rate	\$15,000
Tuition Savings provided by the RSP Tuition Break	\$8,000

Vermont residents saved more than \$3 million on their tuition bills in 2021-22, while enrolled in programs through Tuition Break.

1,500 programs offered with savings on out-of-state tuition

- More than 1,500 programs to choose from – associate, bachelor's, certificate and graduate degree programs in all areas of study
- 74 colleges and universities in the five other New England states offer their programs through Tuition Break
 - 31 state colleges and universities
 - 43 community colleges

How program are approved for eligibility through Tuition Break

- The colleges and universities approve program offerings and eligibility for Tuition Break on an annual basis.
- In most cases, Vermont residents are eligible for programs, because they are *not offered* by the Vermont state colleges or the University of Vermont.
- At certain colleges, Vermont residents are eligible for additional programs even if they are offered in Vermont – such as when an out-of-state college is closer to a Vermont resident's home.
