Why it's important?

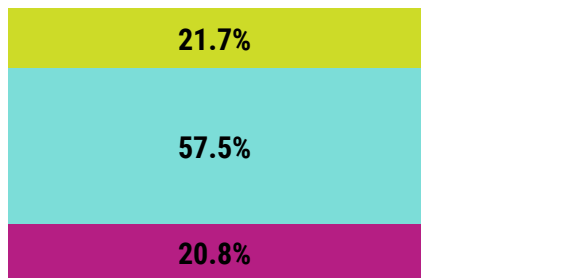
The U.S. Department of Education uses the FAFSA to determine eligibility for federal student aid, including low-cost loans, grants, and work-study. The FAFSA also determines eligibility for a Vermont State Grant and school aid as well.

Everyone should file a FAFSA!



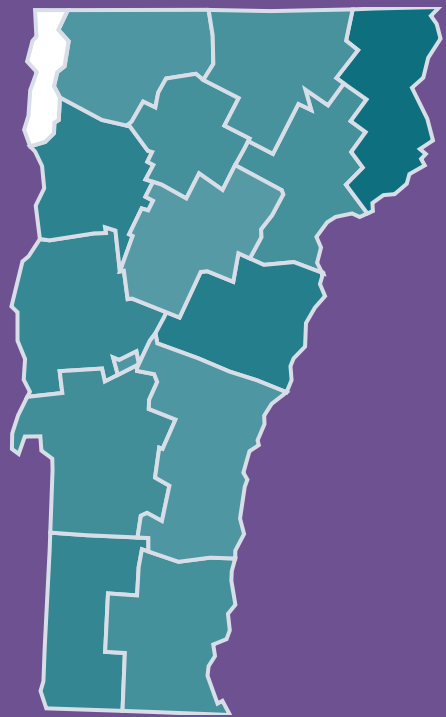
Among 2018 HS Seniors planning to enroll in the fall...

FAFSA Submission Rate: 2019-2020 Cycle

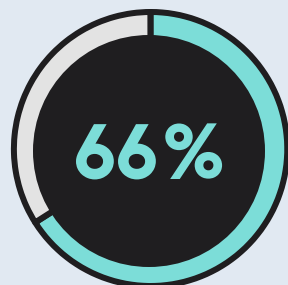
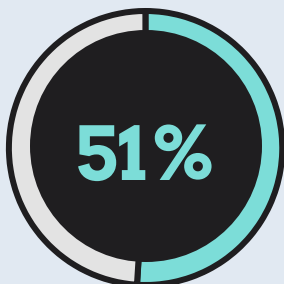


% of Class of 2019 HS Graduates who filed a FAFSA for 2019-2020 Cycle
