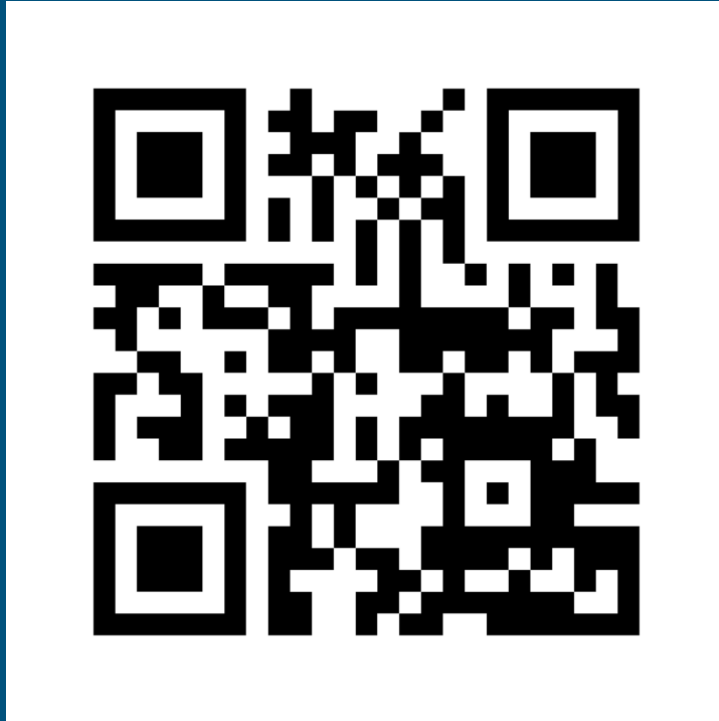


Credit Scores
