## Types

- Vermont grant
  - Full Time
    - Early College
  - Part Time
  - [802 Opportunity](#) – increase in family income eligibility for 2022-2023
- Vermont Advancement Grant (non-degree or non-Title IV eligible)
- Microgrants

# Vermont grant

---

## Vermont grant application

- Degree grant available October 1 for 2023–2024: **Choose the right year.**
- Two ways to apply:
  - Connect directly from submitted FAFSA to Vermont grant application.
  - At **vsac.org** by clicking on MyVSAC button. All applicants need MyVSAC account.
- Uploader: Parent and student tax and W2 uploader using MyVSAC.
- Requested worksheets can be filled out and submitted online.
- Special Circumstances still need to be communicated in writing to Grant Program at VSAC.

**Awarding:** Anticipated for April 2023.

# Vermont grant

---

## Auto renewal for Vermont degree grants

Student needs to have a completed Vermont grant application in 2022-2023.

- 2023–2024 will occur after returning college student files FAFSA and VSAC receives FAFSA data.
- Need a new VT grant application if:
  - Parent on the FAFSA changed
  - Dependency status changed
  - UVM Med or Veterinary student
  - Denied residency prior year

# FAFSA/VT grant completion tool

---

- Available to all Vermont high schools that sign an MOU.
- High schools obtain access through MyVSAC.
- High schools upload senior class information to MyVSAC

## Information shared with high schools

- Was a FAFSA received? If so, submission date and process date are populated.
- No dates? FAFSA is not on record at VSAC as having been submitted.
- Was Vermont grant application received?
- Was student selected for federal verification?

# Vermont Advancement Grant

## Advancement Grant application

- Currently still accepting applications for 2022–2023 funding.
- Applications for classes beginning July 1, 2023, or later should be available in May 2023.
- To apply online, applicants need a MyVSAC account.  
Can't remember MyVSAC info? Follow prompts to reset password; **do not** create a new account.
- Maximum of two (2) state grants per year, \$7,500 Advancement Grant funds limit per year.
