



Workforce Development Funding

A program for aspiring
nursing teachers



An interest-free forgivable loan that pays up to 100% of your tuition.

The Vermont Nurse Faculty Forgivable Loan Program pays up to full tuition for qualified recipients enrolled in a program that leads to a graduate degree in nursing, including APRN, MSN and DSN, that qualifies them to teach at a nursing school in Vermont.

- The program is open to Vermont residents and non-resident students enrolled at least half time.
- Must be enrolled in a program at an accredited school that leads to a graduate degree in nursing, including APRN, MSN and DSN, that qualifies them to teach at a nursing school in Vermont.
- Recipients are eligible for up to full tuition for their program, not to exceed [UVM's in-state tuition rate](#). If you are receiving other tuition-specific aid, this award may be used to pay for room, board, and the cost of books and supplies, however, the total award amount cannot exceed the cost of your program's tuition or UVM's in-state tuition rate, whichever is less.

Awards are in the form of an interest-free loan that is forgiven when the recipient signs a promissory note and has completed the following work obligations:

- Agree to work full-time as a member of the nurse faculty at a nursing school in Vermont for a minimum of one year following licensure for each year of funding received.

Deadlines to apply: Applications are accepted and reviewed on a rolling basis.

Funding is limited and not guaranteed and is awarded to qualifying applicants on a first-come, first-served basis until all funds have been depleted.
