An interest-free forgivable loan that pays up to 100% of your tuition.

The Vermont Nursing Forgivable Loan Program covers up to full tuition for qualified recipients pursuing a nursing career in Vermont.



The program is open to Vermont residents and non-resident students enrolled at an accredited school in one of the following programs:

- A practical nursing certificate, after which a student is eligible to sit for the NCLEX-PN exam
- An associate degree in nursing, after which a student is eligible to sit for the NCLEX-PN exam
- A bachelor of science degree in nursing
- graduate nursing education



Recipients are eligible for up to full tuition for their program, not to exceed [UVM's in-state tuition rate](#). If you are receiving other tuition-specific aid, this award may be used to pay for room, board, and the cost of books and supplies, however, the total award amount cannot exceed the cost of your program's tuition or UVM's in-state tuition rate, whichever is less.

Awards are in the form of an interest-free loan that is forgiven when the recipient signs a promissory note and has completed the following work obligations:



Agree to work as a nurse full-time in VT, employed directly by a Vermont health care provider, for a minimum of one year following licensure for each year of funding

Deadlines to apply: Applications are accepted and reviewed on a rolling basis.

Funding is limited and not guaranteed and is awarded to qualifying applicants on a first-come, first-served basis until all funds have been depleted.
