

Workforce Development Funding

A program for aspiring teachers

An interest-free forgivable loan that pays up to **100% of your tuition.**

The Vermont Teacher Forgivable Loan Program pays up to full tuition for qualified recipients enrolled in a program that leads to a degree or certificate in education and a teaching license.



The program is open to Vermont residents and non-resident students with an emphasis on encouraging Black, Indigenous, and Persons of Color, new Americans, and other historically underrepresented communities.



Must be enrolled in a teaching program at an eligible school that leads to a degree or certificate in education and a teaching license.



Recipients are eligible for up to \$16,280 (including tuition, fees, room, board, books and supplies).

Awards are in the form of an interest-free loan that is forgiven when the recipient signs a promissory note and has completed the following work obligations:



Agree to work full-time as a teacher in a Vermont public school for a minimum of one year following licensure for each year of funding received.

Deadlines to apply: Applications are accepted and reviewed on a rolling basis.

Funding is awarded to qualifying applicants on a first-come, first-served basis until all funds have been depleted.
