

An interest-free forgivable loan that pays up to **100% of your tuition, initial licensing and exam fees.**

The Vermont Trades Forgivable Loan Program covers up to full tuition, initial licensing fees and exam fees for qualified recipients enrolled in industry-recognized training and certification programs.



The program is open to Vermont residents and non-resident students with demonstrated financial need.

Must enroll in an industry recognized training and certification program that leads to a career in select **building**, **mechanical**, **industrial or medical trade**; **emergency services**, **including paramedics**; **energy**, **including clean energy**, **energy efficiency**, **or weatherization**; **transportation**, **including clean transportation**; **broadband**; **robotics or other high demand sectors**.



Must register with VT Department of Labor for the purpose of receiving relevant job referrals, if unemployed.



Recipients are eligible for up to \$23,000 (including initial licensing and exam fees).

Awards are in the form of an interest-free loan that is forgiven when the recipient signs a promissory note and has completed the following work obligations:



Agree to work full-time in their profession in VT for a minimum of one year following licensure or certification completion for each year of funding received.

Deadlines to apply: Applications are accepted and reviewed on a rolling basis.

Funding is awarded to qualifying applicants on a first-come, first-served basis until all funds have been depleted.
