VSAC and the Vermont Department of Health have teamed up to offer a program that pays up to full tuition to qualified recipients pursuing a nursing career in Vermont.

The Vermont Nursing Incentive Program is open to Vermont residents and non-resident students enrolled at an accredited school in one of the following programs:

- A practical nursing certificate, after which a student is eligible to sit for the NCLEX-PN exam
- An associate degree in nursing, after which a student is eligible to sit for the NCLEX-PN exam
- A bachelor of science degree in nursing
- graduate nursing education

Awards are in the form of an interest-free loan that is forgiven when the recipient signs a promissory note and has completed the following work obligations:

Work as a nurse full-time in VT, employed directly by a Vermont health care provider, for a minimum of one year following licensure for each year of award received (cannot be a traveling nurse.)

Deadlines to apply: Applications are accepted and reviewed on a rolling basis.

Funding is awarded to qualifying applicants on a first-come, first-served basis until all funds have been depleted.
