An interest-free forgivable loan that pays up to
100% of your tuition. ←

The Vermont Teacher Forgivable Loan Program pays up to full tuition (maximum \$16,280), which may also cover room, board, books and supplies, for qualified recipients enrolled in a program that leads to a degree or certificate in education and a teaching license.

- The program is open to Vermont residents and non-resident students with an emphasis on encouraging Black, Indigenous, and Persons of Color, new Americans, and other historically underrepresented communities.
- Must be enrolled in a teaching program at an eligible school that leads to a degree or certificate in education and a teaching license.

Awards are in the form of an interest-free loan that is forgiven when the recipient signs a promissory note and has completed the following work obligations:

- Agree to work full-time as a teacher in a Vermont public school for a minimum of one year following licensure for each year of assistance received.

Deadlines to apply: Applications are accepted and reviewed on a rolling basis. Applicants will be notified approximately two weeks after they submit all required documents.

Funding is awarded to qualifying applicants on a first-come, first-served basis until all funds have been depleted.
